Project Description: The Semolina Flour Mill is a 115 foot high structure. Peterson Construction Company formed the frame, which was built with cast-in-place reinforced concrete. The construction presented many challenges, as it was built between and in close proximity to three operating railroad tracks. Three miles of concrete filled pipe piling were installed for the foundation of the structure. As the building neared completion, Peterson Construction Company installed the flour milling equipment.
